Because of the partnership with our local hospital, Harrington Memorial, early on, Southbridge turned its Community Center in to a highly successful vaccination distribution site, serving citizens from across the Commonwealth. Southbridge, like many other communities in the Commonwealth during these unprecedented times, continues to deal with the disruptive and lasting effects of the COVID-19 pandemic; however, we are beginning to see a light at the end of the tunnel.



Southbridge Police Department Mission: The Southbridge Police Department will dedicate itself to work in partnership with the community to fight crime, reduce fear and improve the guality of life in our neighborhoods. By embracing a mutual relationship of support, we remain committed to solving the community's problems and maintaining the public trust.

The Police Department services include: community policing, bicycle patrol, crime scene services, detective unit, domestic violence/family services unit, honor guard, K-9 unit, patrol division, school resource/juvenile officer, animal control officer and auxiliary police

Southbridge Cops & Kids: The Southbridge Police Department's Cops N Kids Program is a year-round effort to reduce juvenile delinguencies and build stronger relationships with Southbridge's youths. Initiated over 20 years ago, this program has seen proven results. In recent years, juvenile delinguency rates have dropped over 85%.

Cops N Kids has grown into a multifaceted approach to transform the young people of today into the citizens we need for tomorrow.

The program,

hosting approximately 150 youths from different walks of life, incorporates academics and athletics with youth agencies and juvenile diversion techniques. For the past five years we have focused our efforts during the summer months. Statistics show youths, aged 9 to 16 years of age, traditionally see a rise in juvenile delinguencies when they are left unsupervised while their parents are at work. In addition, we have partnered with the Project Bread program, which provides breakfast and lunch for these children at no cost, and the Worcester District Attorney's Office and the Juvenile Probation Office visit the program once a week to provide related classes and mentoring. The program also employs college students, who are themselves alumni of this program, to serve as mentors and role models.

Most importantly, we provide a safe and caring environment when these children are most at risk. Our officers are dedicated to the future of Southbridge that is embodied in these children.

Domestic Violence/Family Services: This specialized unit was established in 1996 within the Southbridge Police Department. Officers are frequently sent to violence related training courses to continually monitor and modify our departments anti-violence programs. Officers act as liaisons between our department and different organizations to ensure continuity of safety for the victims. Those contact organizations include: New Hope, Day Break, Battered Shelters, Department of Social Services, Catholic Charities, Southbridge Community Coalition and local hospitals.

Officer Gerald Arvelo is responsible for monitoring all domestic violence related investigations. His duties include filing all domestic violence related paperwork, and keeping restraining orders within the town of Southbridge up to date. He is responsible for follow-up investigations, including home visits and phone calls. He is also responsible for filing all paperwork to other agencies as may be required depending on the incident.

The unit is on call 24 hours a day and is often used to provide transportation for victims to court. The unit is also able to provide cell phones to victims who are in need of communication services. Please contact Officer Arvelo at the Southbridge Police Department with any questions or concerns, or a situation that needs attention.

For immediate service for a domestic violence situation in progress please dial 911.

Animal Control: The Animal Control Officer's (ACO) focus is on educating the public on proper animal care, and rescuing animals from dangerous and/or abusive situations. The Southbridge Police Department currently employs one full-time ACO who is in charge of handling services ranging from investigating animal cruelty, animal fighting rings, sick or injured animals of any origin and providing shelter to animals that are found.

The Southbridge Fire Station was constructed in 1899 on the site which formerly housed a tavern, a blacksmith shop, and a large elm tree for a cost of \$23,000. The station was designed for horse-drawn equipment and manned by a volunteer fire department. The building

was renovated in 1940 and 1961 with additional bays constructed to house the department's growing inventory of equipment. In 1989, the building was listed on the National Register of Historic Places.





S.A.F.E: The Student Awareness of Fire Education (S.A.F.E.) Program is a state initiative to provide resources to local fire departments to conduct fire and life safety education programs in grades K-12. The mission is to enable students to recognize the dangers of fire and more specifically the fire hazards tobacco products pose.

Key Fire Safety Behaviors: There are 23 Key Fire Safety Behaviors that should be taught in age and developmentally appropriate ways, such as: Stop, Drop, and Roll, making and practicing home escape plans, reporting fires and emergencies, crawl low under smoke, smoke detector maintenance, kitchen safety, holiday safety and more.

Fire and life safety is easily combined with math, science, language arts, health, and physical education lessons. Integration into the existing curriculum topics is essential.

Proven Success: Since the S.A.F.E. Program was initially funded, there have been 310 documented YOUNG HEROES – children who put into practice the fire and life safety lessons they learned in the classroom during

a real life emergency to save themselves or others. Many families claim they are alive today because their youngsters "made" them install smoke alarms and practice a home escape plan, or reported an emergency, or persuaded a grandmother to 'stop, drop, and roll'. Child Fire Deaths have drop 72% Since S.A.F.E. started.





The goal of the Southbridge Public Schools is to support cohesive PreK-12 programming so that all students can achieve their full potential. It is the district's goal to develop students who are knowledgeable and skilled, socially competent, civic minded, creative and healthy, and to model a commitment to being lifelong learners.

It is the District's mission that ALL students will experience a world-class education and will graduate as engaged citizens who demonstrate the essential skills required for success in college and career.

Southbridge Public Schools comprises six schools with approximately 2,000 students. The district is currently in State receivership due to a designation in 2015 of "chronically under-performing" status by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. Receiver and superintendent Jeffrey A. Villar, Ph.D., was appointed in February 2018.

Receivership brings with it a variety of resources that assist the community in providing children with a dependable quality education. One example is a longterm partnership with the University of Connecticut to develop Southbridge Public Schools as a national demonstration site for successful implementation of PBIS strategies (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports). Additionally, the district's successful 21st Century Afterschool program provides enrichment and support for the school-day curriculum. The district is also the recipient of a number of significant grants that allow for secondary redesign, curriculum enhancements, and improved culture and climate.





Southbridge was first settled by Europeans in 1730. In 1801 a poll parish, named the Second Religious Society of Charlton, and popularly called Honest Town, was formed from the west part of Dudley, the southwest part of Charlton and the southeast part of Sturbridge. In

1816 this parish was incorporated to become the township of Southbridge. Among the first settlers was Moses Marcy, who owned a home on the site of what is now Notre Dame church and was elected to Congress, and the Dennison family. Water power from the Quinebaug River made Southbridge a good location for sawmills and gristmills in the 18th century, and textile mills in the 19th century. After the Civil War, many immigrants of Irish and French Canadian descent came to work and live there; by the 1930s they had been joined by Poles, Greeks, Italians and others.

Southbridge has a long history of manufacturing optical products, earning it the unofficial title "Eye of the Commonwealth", in reference to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Under the Wells family, the American Optical Company ("A0") became the world's largest manufacturer of ophthalmic products, and at its height employed more than 6,000 people around the world. Many of its workers were exempted from the draft during World War II since they were doing vital defense work, including




making Norden bombsights and even some work on the atomic bomb. The site of the former AO (The AO shut down in 1984) now houses the Southbridge Hotel & Conference **Center and historical touches reflecting** the building's 160 heritage as the home of eyeglass manufacturer can be seen throughout the social areas.

Félix Gatinea (11/12/1857-12/21/1927) was a French Canadian statesman and historian



in his adopted hometown of Southbridge. He was born in Sainte-Victoire-de-Sorel, Quebec, and arrived in Southbridge in 1877. Among his many deeds, he was a state representative in Massachusetts in 1906, 1920-21and 1927, and led several French-Canadian societies. His written works include L'Histoire des Franco-Américains de Southbridge and L'Historique des Conventions Générales des Canadiens-Français aux Etats-Unis. A statue was erected in his honor and dedicated on September 1, 1927, at a fork in a main road in Southbridge by the Union Saint-Jean-Baptiste d'Amérique, as he was one of the society's founders. The Gatineau bust often serves as a wayfinder, with locals directing people "Félix to the left" or "Félix to the right."

Celebrating their 24th year in 2021, this four day family event is designed to be a holiday activity. The mission is to raise money to help the Silent Spring Institute www.silentspring.org, the Massachusetts Breast Cancer Coalition www.mbcc.org and the Cancer Center at Harrington Hospital to fight the battle against breast cancer and to help fund cancer research. Over these years, the Festival of {Giving} Trees has raised and donated over \$695.000 to these beneficiaries.

The Festival of {Giving} Trees features more than 100 uniquely decorated trees on display under one roof. Some are elegant, nostalgic and breathtaking. Some are humorous, some are traditional and some are really hip. The only thing they have in common is that they are all different and they are all sparkling! Notre Dame Parish was founded in 1869 to serve the needs of the French Canadian community of Southbridge who migrated here beginning in the 1830s. A frame wood church was built shortly thereafter. The

second Pastor Msgr Georges Elzar Brochu began to

raise funds for a much larger church in the 1880s. In 1895 Msgr Brochu purchased land at the corner of Main and Marcv for the new church. Part of the purchase agreement stipulated that the church could not actually be built until after the death of Mr. Marcy, the prior owner. As a result, Msgr Brochu, who died in 1904 was unable to begin construction which was eventually undertaken by his successor, Msgr Louis O. Trigonne after Mr. Marcy died in 1908. Notre Dame Catholic Church was built from 1912–1916 and added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1989. The organ at Notre Dame Church was built in 1916 by the Casavant Frères Pipe Organ Company of Saint-Hyacinthe, Quebec, Opus 64 and is one of the largest and most complete instruments of any Catholic church in the State of Massachusetts.







removed. The shingle and clapboard siding with the dentil work on two levels, are of note. Sign for J. Goldstein & Co. New York Dry Goods & Clothing House, sign for M. L. Brainard, Watchmaker & Jeweler, sign for Optician on the glass of one of the store fronts and sign for Ladies' Cream Cafe on a wooden sign, announce some of the business ventures operating in the building. In front are some hitching posts for horses at the side of the curb. When in operation, the Southbridge Sturbridge Street Railway used to pass in front of this building. The building was refurbished in 2004.



SCM Elderbus is a private non-profit 501 (c) 3 organization. Incorporated in 1974, the Company initially provided transportation to medical appointments for senior residents of a single community. Under the auspices of the Worcester Regional Transit Authority, today the organization provides transportation services to seniors and the disabled residing in twenty-one communities in central Massachusetts.



Southbridge station is a former train station built by the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad (NYNH&H). The building was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1989 as New York, New Haven & Hartford Passenger Depot. Southbridge's railroad service began

in 1866, with service provided by the Blackstone and Southbridge Railroad. The track originally extended further to the northwest, nearer the Hamilton Woolen Company mill complex, where there once stood passenger and freight depots and an office building. After a series of

mergers, the service was taken over by the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad in 1907. This depot was built by that railroad in 1910, and served as a passenger station until 1930.




On Sept. 30, 1958, JFK made a campaign stop in Southbridge at the urging of the town's Democratic Party leaders. He greeted people on a downtown

sidewalk before making a stump speech at the corner of Main and Central streets.



On the day JFK Kennedy spoke in downtown Southbridge, he was accompanied by his wife Jacqueline and his remarks included a push for an increase in the minimum wage, to \$1.25 an hour. The itinerary for the day shows other campaign stops in Spencer, Webster and Uxbridge.


The image above shows him speaking in front of Billis Diner, which at the time, was part of the Maci Building, or the Masonic Building, at 92 Main St. The brick building, once anchored by the C.A. Dresser House hotel, was a key part of Southbridge's downtown for seven decades.





Westville Lake Recreation Area

Southbridge. The facility's easy access distinguishes Westville Lake as a popular outdoor recreation area. The Quinebaug River, once harnessed for mills and factories at several locations within the park, now meanders parallels the Quinebaug River and is a popular walking trail. The river and its tributaries serve as the center of of Engineers owns and manages 578 acres of land at Westville Lake. Field, forest, and wetland environments provide habitats for a variety of wildlife species.



enjoyed by softball and soccer enthusiasts as well as the occasional kite flyer. Several picnic tables and grills are situated throughout the recreation area. Two large picnic shelters accommodate group gatherings and can be reserved for a fee. The picnic shelters have multiple tables, two large grills, electrical outlets, and a wonderful view of the lake and dam. There is no fee to enter or use Westville Recreation Area, however there are some fees charged to reserve some park facilities such as the small picnic shelter, large picnic shelter and ball fields

Anglers can find an abundance of warm water fish in the lake including large-mouth bass and panfish. The State of Massachusetts stocks the Quinebaug River above the dam with trout creating a popular fly-fishing location. For boating and canoeing enthusiasts, two boat launches provide easy access to the lake and the slow-moving portions of the river. There are more than three miles of trails with terrain varying from the flat rail bed of the Grand Trunk to rolling hills of the Community Trail. During the winter months, though the entry gates are closed, the recreation area remains a popular destination due to its offering of ice skating, sledding, snow shoes and crosscountry skiing. Pets are welcome but must be leashed at all times and pet owners are responsible for cleanup and disposal of all pet waste.


